


CRAFT activity Sunday 3rd May

Rejoice always, pray continually, give thanks in all circumstances; for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus.

What you'll need: Paper, scissors colouring pencils/pens **OR** coloured chalk and something to toss such as a ball. You can either do this activity on paper or turn it into a game to play on a pavement. Instructions for both are below...

	ON PAPER	ON A PAVEMENT
Step 1	Draw around something circular like a jam pot lid – if you want to make the game more challenging, draw around something much smaller like a coin. Draw 10 circles in total.	Take your chalk outside and draw 10 large circles on the pavement. Place them randomly or in a straight line – it's up to you. You could draw around something like a plastic bowl or a cake tin – ask for permission to take it outside first.
Step 2	Colour 3 circles blue, 3 circles red, 3 circles yellow and leave one circle white. If you haven't got those colours, choose different ones but stick to 3,3,3,1. Step 3	Cut your circles out. Keep some of your scraps and scrumple them up to make a tight little ball. Tidy everything else away.	Get something light like a ball, or you could make a paper aeroplane. This will be your marker.
Step 4	Place your circles on a table and close together if you want to make it easy or on the floor and further apart if you want to make it harder.	Take your ball, aeroplane or whatever you've chosen as your marker and toss it to try and land on a circle. When you land on a coloured circle, do what it says below this table.
Step 5	Take your tight little ball of scrunpled paper and toss it to try and land on a circle. When you land on a coloured circle, do what it says below this table.	
<p>If you land on...</p> <p>Red / colour 1 = Leap for joy and say or sing something out loud that you're really happy about.</p> <p>Yellow / colour 2 = Say the Lord's prayer out loud – ask an adult to teach you if you don't know it. Here it is for you on the right...</p> <p>Blue / colour 3 = Do the sign language sign for 'Thank you!' and say something you're thankful for. (Sign language thank you – touch your chin and extend your hand and forearm away from you in an outwards and slightly down motion as the boy in the picture is doing)</p> <p>White / Clear = Do 10 star jumps!</p> <p><i>You can add to the game by making each circle worth a certain amount of points and get someone in your household to play with you. Who'll win?</i></p>		<p><i>Our Father in heaven, hallowed be your Name, your kingdom come, your will be done, on earth as in heaven. Give us today our daily bread.
