What is our only hope in life and death?

Based on Romans 14:7-12

READ: In the book “The Tale of Peter Rabbit” by Beatrix Potter, one of the sentences is “The rabbit’s only hope was that Mr. McGregor would not find him in the watering can.”

The words mean that the rabbit recognises that it needs some help to escape. When we hope for help, we must trust somebody or something. In our lives we hope for many things and the Bible teaches us that we must trust in God. Even though we have mums and dads to ask for help and we’re part of a family, we’re part of a bigger family that will support us – God’s family!
